**Recommendations of Experts-** In the seminar on “Environment and Bioscience” held on 2-3 March, 2013 certain two issues like current trends in environmental pollution, environmental degradation and toxicology, issues related to ecological development (economics, social, cultural, moral and technological), human wildlife conflict, environmental education and awareness, floral and faunal diversity. Biodiversity conservation and role of nano - technology were widely addressed and discussed by the learned delegates, resource persons (Dr. Pant, ITRC, Lucknow), patron (J.D. Mitra, Director Higher Education, U.P.) and Chief Guest (V.C., M.A.J.U.). It was critically resolved to create awareness among the students and local community about the environmental protection (measure to reduce toxicants/pollutants and create hygienic conditions). Furthermore, measures relating to control of insect vectors responsible for transmitting infectious diseases were also focused. Needs and mechanisms for eradicating infect parts need to be widely publicized. Keeping in view the environmental degradation, further researching on toxicological aspects and biotechnological aspects need to be strengthened in educational institution. On this occasion 17<sup>th</sup> annual convection of U.P. Government Colleges Academic society was also organized. Delegates from different govt. colleges attained two sessions and presented their papers. Session was quite useful.
